

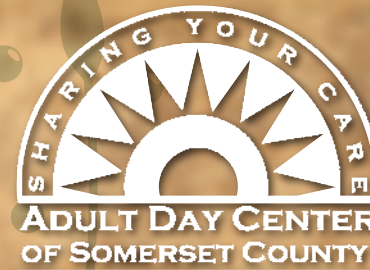

Supporting the ADC through a Planned Gift

Cash gifts and pledges are not the only ways to provide financial support to the ADC. You may consider one of the planned giving vehicles below:
